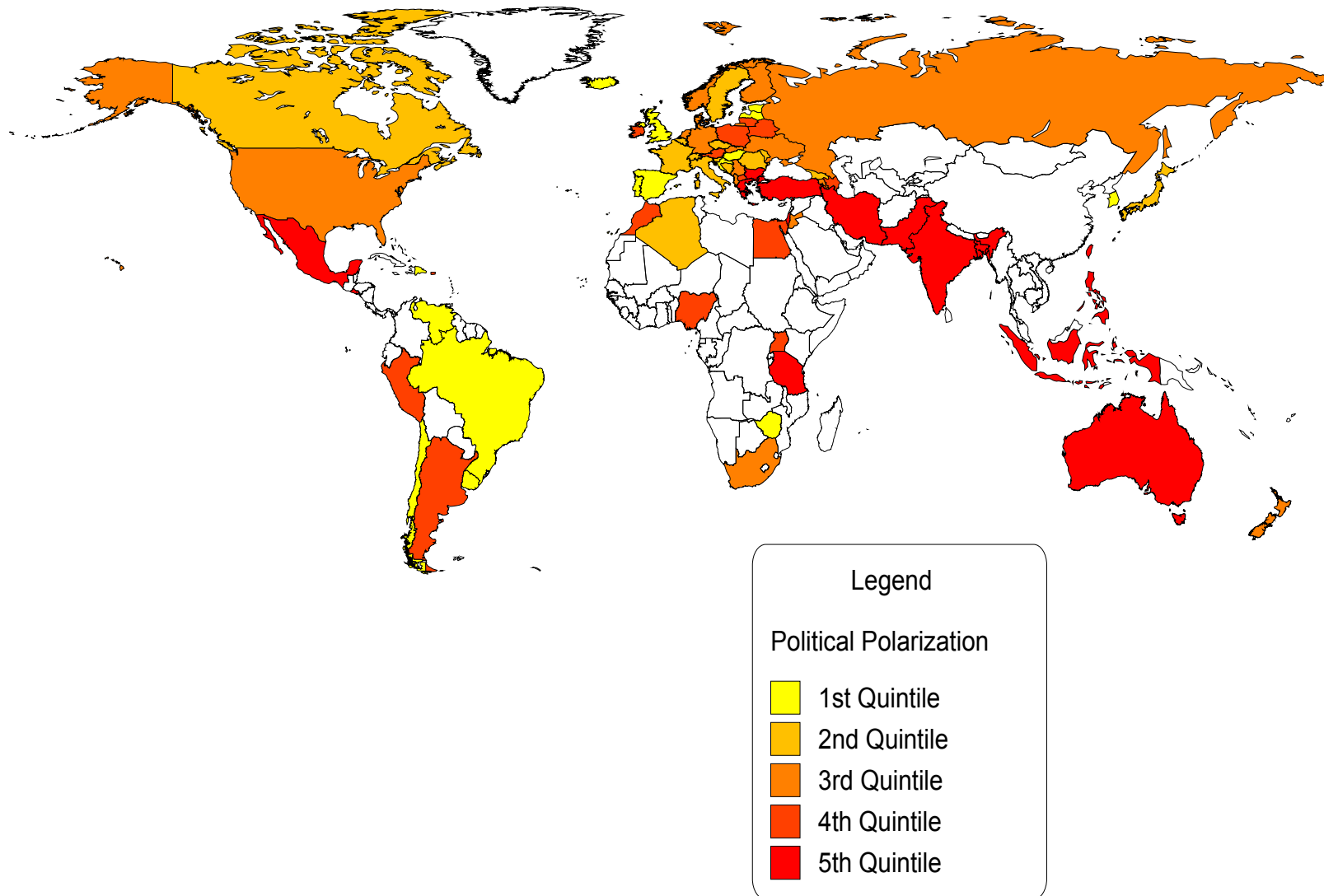


Figure 4. World Map with the ordinal levels of political polarization.

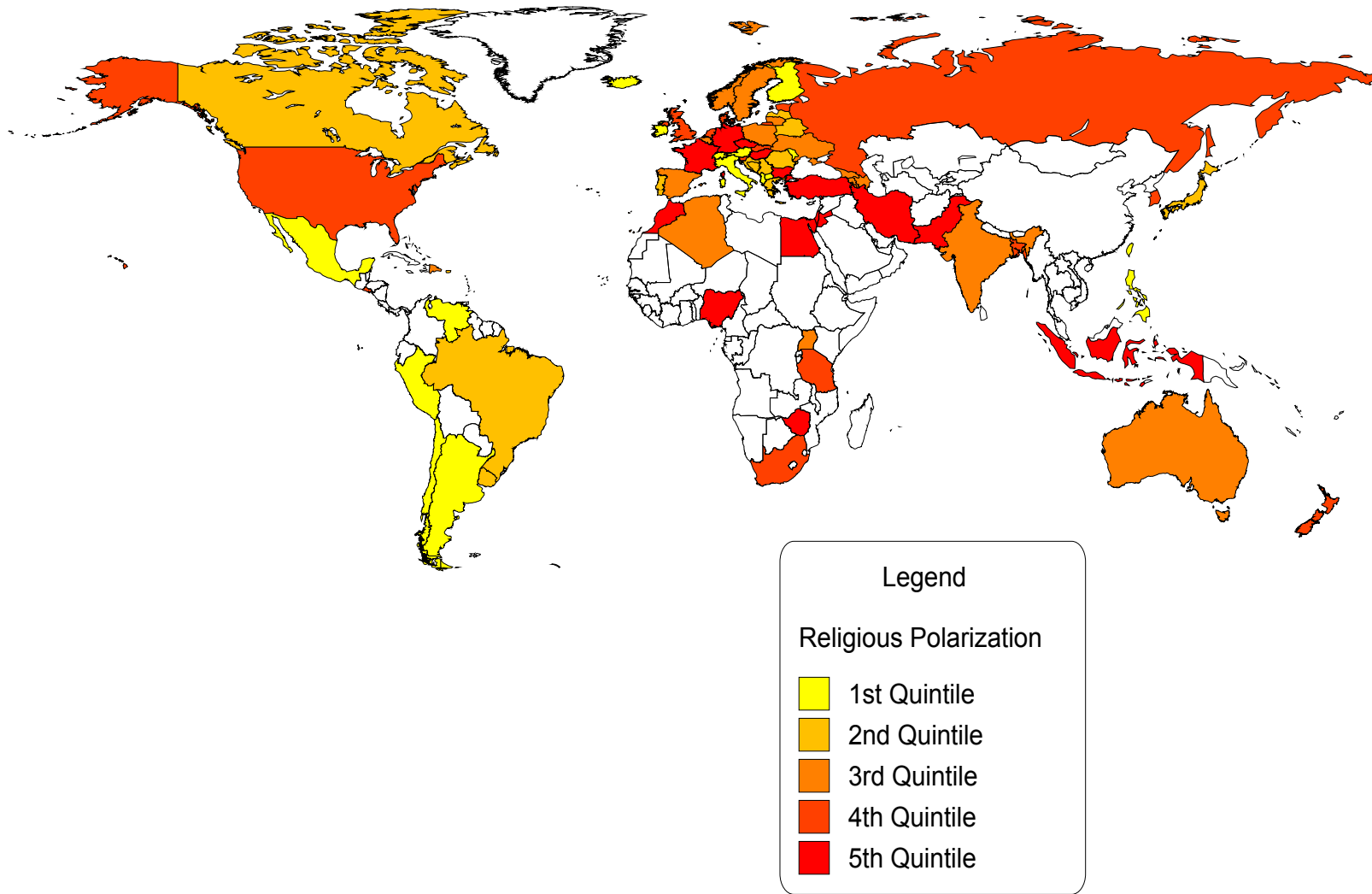


Figure 5. World Map with the ordinal levels of religious polarization.
